1. INTRODUCTION

This description of the website is a Deliverable of the Work Package 7 (Demonstrator and Dissemination). Since the website is developing with the project and its requirements, it is supposed to be a “living document”. This document describes the website as a key instrument for dissemination.

The MOBVIS project web site has been established in its own web domain. The site can be found at URL <http://www.mobvis.org/>. Physically, the site is maintained on a server at the Coordinator’s premises, i.e. at JOANNEUM RESEARCH, Institute of Digital Image Processing (server name “dibs002.joanneum.at”). A first version of the site has been operational since the Kick-Off meeting of the MOBVIS project (cf. Figure 1).

2. WEBSITE ENTRY PAGE

The MOBVIS website includes on the front page the executive summary as it is part of the EU contract in Annex I.

Additionally, the site contains sections targeting at including the following content,

- **Objectives** – a description of the project, in particular, the research challenges (object and context awareness, intelligent maps, attentive interface, and an integrated demonstrator).
- **Partners** – a description of consortium and links to partner’s individual web sites (cf. Figure 2).
- **Demos** – a collection of videos and reports describing stages of the demonstrator development.
- **Events** – MOBVIS related events (project meetings, conferences, workshops, etc.)
- **Public Relations** – press releases about the project.
- **Reports** – deliverable reports.
- **Publications** – a list of publications of the consortium in the context of the MOBVIS project
- **Links** - links to EU related sites (Cognition Unit etc.), thematic web sites related to MOBVIS research, links to tutorials etc.
- **Contact** – a page dedicated to contact the project coordinator.
- **Internal login** – a link to the MOBVIS Wiki page that is only accessible to MOBVIS partners.
